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MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

of

All India Forest Officer's Federation

1. NAME OF THE SOCIETY:

The name of the Society shall be "All India Forest Officer's Federation" which shall be registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1860 and the rules framed thereunder.

2. REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE SOCIETY

The registered office of the Federation shall be temporarily situated in the South East district of the National Capital Territory of Delhi at House No. C-4, Staff Quarters, National Zoological Park, Sunder Nagar, Matura Road, New Delhi - 110 003.

3. AREA OF OPERATION OF THE SOCIETY

The area of operation of the Society shall be the entire territorial jurisdiction of India.

4. AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY

The aims and objects to be pursued by the Society shall be as follows:

To work to safeguard interests of the forest officers and officials of the country serving under any Government, such as, State Governments, Union Territories, Central Government, local bodies/ authorities etc. holding any ranks or positions, related to duties, responsibilities, service conditions, working environment, safety, security, rights, privileges and welfare of the forest officers and officials of the country.

To work for fostering and developing unity and fraternity among different unions, associations, society, organisations and formal groups of the forest officers and officials in the country for the welfare of the forest officers and officials.

- (iii) To work for common interests and grievances of the forest officers and officials of the country including their duties, responsibilities, service conditions, working environment, safety, security, rights, privileges and welfare.
- (iv) To develop coordination and arrive at consensus among different unions, associations, societies, bodies, formal and informal groups of the forest officers and officials in the country on the issues of common interests and welfare of the forest officers and officials.
- (v) To raise and place before the appropriate Government authorities the grievances and issues of common interests and welfare of the forest officers and officials of the country for appropriate remedial action and redressal of grievances by the concerned authorities.
- (vi) To take appropriate action and measures, by peaceful and lawful means, for redressal of grievances and issues of common interests and welfare of the forest officers and officials of the country related to their duties, responsibilities, service conditions, working environment, safety, security, rights, privileges and welfare.
- (vii) To serve as the forum for consultation, negotiation, conciliation with the appropriate authorities in the Government on the issues related to duties, responsibilities, service conditions, working environment, safety, security, rights, privileges and welfare of the forest officers and officials of the country and also for implementation of plans and policies of the Government for all round development and progress of the state, region or country.
- (viii) To settle disputes among the forest officers and officials of the country, if any.
- (ix) To extend all requisite and necessary support and assistance in the event of any unfortunate accident, sickness, unemployment, physical invalidation, death, natural or manmade disaster, distress and difficulties involving the

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forest officers and officials of the country and their spouses, parents and/ or children.

(x) To provide financial support and assistance to the forest officers and officials of the country and their parents, spouses and children in the event of any unfortunate accident, sickness, unemployment, physical invalidation, death, natural or manmade disaster, distress and difficulties.

(xi) To take up matter with appropriate and concerned authorities for all help and support including financial assistance and or payment of compensation to the concerned forest officers and officials of the country and their parents, spouses and children in the event any accident, injury, invalidity, or death involving them.

(xii) To ameliorate and improve the social, financial and official condition of the forest officers and officials of the country and their family members.

To forge unity, fraternity and solidarity among the forest officers and officials of the country.

(xiv) To work as a forum for discussion, deliberations and consultations for the forest officers and officials of the country on the issues of common interests, welfare and common cause.

(xv) To nominate one or more representative of the All India Forest Officers Federation on the unions, associations, society, organisations and formal groups of the forest officers and officials affiliated with the Federation.

(xvi) To place before the concerned authorities and/ or the government suggestions for improvements with respect to duties, responsibilities, service conditions, working environment, safety, security, rights, privileges and welfare of the forest officers and officials of the country.

(xvii) To work unitedly for all round development of the country and for conservation, protection and sustainable utilization of natural resources of the country as per the national and international goals in the matter.

- (xviii) To identify the needs of capacity building of the human resources engaged in the field of Environmental Conservation, natural resources management and Wildlife Management, including identification of types of skills, knowledge and attitude required for conservation and management of the natural resources to achieve national and global standards in manpower productivity.
- (xix) To seek help, coordinate with, or work in association with any other unions, associations, society, organisations, institutions and groups to achieve the objects and purposes of the Federation.
- (xx) To undertake works for the welfare and improvement of the quality of life for economic and social upliftment of the forest officers and officials in the country.
- (xxi) To collaborate with or become a member or create partnership or sign MoU with any national, international institutions, organisations, associations or body for the welfare of the forest officers and officials in the country.
- (xxii) To enter into any arrangements with any Government(s) or authorities whether Central, State, municipal, local or any other person, that may seem conducive to the objects of the Society.
- (xxiii) To organize and participate in seminars, conferences, fairs related to the objects of the Society and to compile, collate, edit and publish technical reports and papers related to the objects of the Society.
- (xxiv) To acquire, construct, erect, develop, improve, or alter and keep in repair any building acquired or used by or for the Federation and to pull down or demolish or dispose of any building not so required or for renovation and reconstruction and to maintain, deal with, manage, control and administer the same.
- (xxv) To pay all expenses, preliminary or incidental to the formation of the Federation and its registration.

(xxvi) To run training institutions, centres of learning, create and circulate mass media educational awareness and study materials and publish books, reports, journals, magazines, newspapers, periodicals, thesis, researches, writings, discoveries, documents, news and information for achievement of the objects and purposes of the Federation.

5. **The Functions and Powers of the Society:** The functions and the powers of the Federation / society shall be as set out in the rules and regulations of the Federation/ society.

6. **Certified copy of Rules of Business for Society:** A certified copy of the Rules of Business for Federation/ Society as Rules and Regulations of the Society filed as Part C is an integral part of the Memorandum of Association.

7. **Activities of the Society:**

- (i). Undertake all activities required for achievement of objects and purposes of the Federation.
- (ii). Develop and manage all administrative and financial systems for day to day functioning of the Federation.
- (iii). Establish and operate multi-dimensional, interdisciplinary institutions, facilities for achievement of objects and purposes of the Federation.

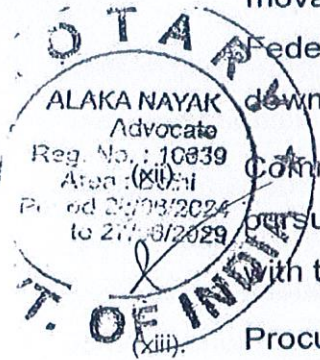
Delegate defined powers, functions and responsibilities to each of the office bearer and level of the officers and officials of the Federation for achievement of the objectives of the Society;

(iv). Develop and compile data and knowledge base, with innovative initiatives in areas, related to duties, responsibilities, service conditions, working environment, safety, security, rights, privileges and welfare of the forest officers and officials of the country.

(v). Develop and compile data and knowledge base, with innovative initiatives in areas, related to different unions, associations, societies,

bodies, formal and informal groups in the country of the forest officers and officials.

- (vii). Identify, plan, develop and implement programs and activities for achievement of objects and purposes of the Federation.
- (viii). Establish technical, administrative, secretarial and other posts in the Federation for day-to-day functioning of the Federation for achievement of its objects and purposes.
- (ix). Open and operate bank accounts in the scheduled banks of the country along with the signatories to the account.
- (x). Receive grants of money, securities of property and undertake and accept management of any funds consistent with the objectives of the Federation;
- (xi). Purchase, hire, lease, exchange or otherwise acquire property both movable and immovable, in pursuance of the objectives of the Federation and in accordance with the rules in force and procedure laid down by the Federation.
- (xii). Commit funding as received from Government or any other source in pursuance of the stated objectives of the Federation and in accordance with the stated purpose of the funding agency;
- (xiii). Procure the services of specialists, consultants and NGOs and external support, as required, in compliance with financial constraints to achieve the aims and objects of the Federation;
- (xiv). Prepare annual budget and incur approved expenditure for the execution and implementation of the works of the Federation.
- (xv). Monitor timely and adequate flow of funds particularly from all sources with specific internal financial control of funds, processes and external checks and audits.
- (xvi). Prepare Annual Reports of the Federation every year and made



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available to the desirous members and forest officers and officials of the country.

(xvii). Establish technical resources support base through existing institutions or through establishment of new ones.

(xviii). Conduct workshops, seminars, and conferences to disseminate information, share experiences and learning related to duties, responsibilities, service conditions, working environment, safety, security, rights, privileges and welfare of the

- Forest officials and officers working under different State Governments, Union Territories Administration/ Government, Central Government etc in the country.
- Other Government employees working under different departments of the State Governments, Union Territories Administration/ Government, Central Government etc
- Forest personnel working in the different countries of the world related to management, conservation and protection of the natural resources.

(xix). To sign MOU or work in association with other departments of Government, the public, forest dependent communities; Civil Society Organizations, research and academic organizations, advocacy groups, rural and urban self-government bodies / institutions, district departments, local communities, chambers, confederations, press and media personnel and other agencies for the object and purposes of the Federation.

Enter into contracts and undertake any legal action that may be necessary to ensure fulfilment of obligations under the contracts made between the Federation and others, including individuals, organizations, associations, institutions or body corporate.

(xx). Exercise overall responsibility for management of the Federation within the framework of Federation bye-laws.

- (xxii). Any other activities that are required to be implemented to achieve the purpose and objectives of the society.

All the income, earnings, moveable, and immovable properties of the Society shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only, as set forth in the Memorandum of Association, and no profit on thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or past Members of the Society. Also, no Member of the Society shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the Society or make any profits whatsoever, by virtue of his membership, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment, in good faith, of remuneration to any member thereof, or other person, in return for any services rendered to the Society, or for any services rendered to the Society, or for traveling allowances, halting or similar charges.

8. GOVERNING BODY

The names, addresses, occupations and designations of the members of the first Governing Body to whom the management and affairs of the Society is entrusted as required under Section 2 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, as applicable to the (All India Forest officer's federation) in the State of Delhi N.C.T. are as follows:-

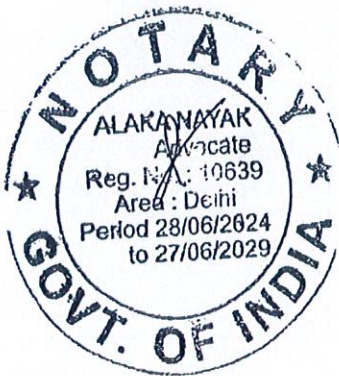


9. DESIROUS PERSONS
